Kit List

Scout Uniform Or Hoody (to be worn on arrival and departure to site)
If a hoody is worn, uniform will still need to be packed.

All of the items below should be packed into a single bag/rucksack and
clearly named

Warm Sleeping Bag & Pillow

Roll Matt (Carry Matt) and blanket (or similar)

Waterproof jacket and over trousers (if you have them)

Lots of Sweatshirts/Jumpers (long sleeved and hooded ones are best)

Lots of T-Shirts

Trousers (not jeans as these take ages to dry out)

Underwear and Socks

Strong Shoes or Boots

Wash Kit and Towels

Sun Cream & Sun Hat Clearly labelled with Scouts Name

Insect Repellent Clearly labelled with Scouts Name

Torch and spare batteries

Pack of Cards or a small Game

Plastic bags for wet clothing

News Paper for fire lighting

Appropriate Clothes, Shoes and a towel

Personal Medications

(all of which should have been notified on consent form)

The following items are banned from the camp and will be taken from the
